Parish Finances

The parish fiscal year ended on June 30, and the Parish Finance Committee met on August 7 and 21 to review the Annual Report (see enclosed). The meetings were attended by Fr. O'Connor, Donna Anderson, Joan O'Brien, Brady Sherman and George Williams.

At the August 7 meeting the committee reviewed the balance of our various accounts, and determined that the interest from endowment account should be utilized for the Queen of Snows project. The financial report was completed after this meeting and it was then signed by the committee members at the August 21 meeting.

The committee also reviewed upcoming expenditures including repairs at Corpus Christi Church, the rectory, Mulligan Hall and Queen of the Snows. There was some discussion regarding Parish income sources, with Fr. O'Connor sharing the Parish Stewardship Manual. Active parishioner participation is necessary for the health of the parish.

The Endowment Trust Fund Board of Trustees are: Fr. O'Connor, George Williams, Joan O'Brien, Brady Sherman and Donna Anderson. George Williams is the current President of the Board and he and Fr. O'Connor signed the Charter.
